



HOW CONVENTION OF STATES CAN HELP END THE BORDER CRISIS

THE ONGOING HUMANITARIAN CRISIS on the southern border stands as one of the most pressing issues of our time, and yet, the federal government seems unwilling to address it. Here's what you need to know:

- ▶ **President Joe Biden's failure to enforce** the southern border has unleashed chaos in Texas, with repercussions reverberating nationwide.
- ▶ **Texas has taken decisive action to safeguard its citizens** amidst federal inaction, leading to an escalating conflict with the Biden administration.
- ▶ **Twenty-five governors expressed solidarity** with Texas Governor Greg Abbott's efforts to secure the southern border.
- ▶ The joint statement from governors **condemns the Biden administration for leaving Americans vulnerable** to unprecedented illegal immigration, drug trafficking, and potential terrorist infiltration.
- ▶ **The constitutional remedy lies in Article V, empowering states to counter federal overreach** through an amendments convention. Thirty-four states are needed to call a convention; 19 have already passed Convention of States applications.
- ▶ **By invoking Article V, states can gain joint jurisdiction over international borders** and enact laws to prevent illegal entry, empowering them to safeguard their citizens.
- ▶ While the support of states *is* important, merely petitioning the president falls short; **it's time for concrete action to secure our border and freedom against federal encroachment.**
